## Squirt Sees A Happy Future:

*The Role of Special Needs Funding*

A few months ago, we shared with you the story of Squirt, a 5 year old Manchester Terrier who was found wandering around a Denver light rail station in the winter of 2011. At 9 pounds, he was starving, and was less than half the weight he should have been. He was also blind and had out-of-control diabetes. The blindness was caused by cataracts, which most likely resulted from his diabetes.

Thankfully for Squirt, some rescuers brought him to MaxFund, and he received a new lease on life at the MaxFund Wellness Center. Thanks to regular meals and twice-daily insulin injections to control his diabetes, he filled back out to a healthy 20 pounds. Although blind, he managed to find his way into the heart of everyone who met him. He's spunky, friendly, active, and affectionate. He doesn't think 20 pounds is too much for a lap dog to weigh, so he does enjoy lap-sitting...at least when he's not running around being a typical Manchester Terrier!

The only thing missing was Squirt's eyesight. Although he didn't let his blindness stop him, it caused him to bump into obstacles. Blindness also presents an obstacle to adoption. Not every adopter wants to take on the care of a dog with multiple physical and/or medical needs. So we asked Dr. Nuhsbaum, the wonderful ophthalmologist at VRCC, to evaluate him. She pronounced him a good candidate for cataract surgery! So now, all Squirt needed was money...lots of it. Even with a generous discount from VRCC, the cost of the surgery was around \$3300.

MaxFund allocates a substantial portion of its annual budget to medical care. After all, our core mission is to take in injured and sick strays, heal them, and then find great homes for them. Still, our medical budget is not unlimited. So we must prioritize. The most urgent medical priority is to provide life-saving or emergency care to the animals who need it immediately. And we had many urgent and expensive cases this summer. We took in 15 puppies with parvo, a fast-moving viral infection with a very high mortality rate. Without hospitalization and round-the-clock care, most puppies with parvo don't make it. And the shame of it is that parvo is easily prevented with proper vaccinations. We are so pleased that 9 of our parvo puppies survived, and have been adopted into their forever homes!



Squirt

Squirt's situation was a little different from that of the parvo puppies. While the restoration of his eyesight would be a huge quality-of-life enhancement, it was not a life-saving or emergency treatment. We made a commitment to Squirt that we would restore his vision, but the priority for the use of our medical funds this summer was to save the lives of the parvo puppies. We knew, though, that the sooner Squirt's eyesight could be restored, the sooner he would be able to see his way clear to a great future.

So...we turned to you, our wonderful supporters. We started a fund-raising effort for Squirt, using an article in Paw Prints, a direct email appeal, and an Indiegogo campaign. We were overwhelmed by the response! Within days of
