Daisy Mae Has a Holiday Wish

Daisy Mae is an adorable young Dachshund who was recently relinquished to MaxFund. When she came to us, she was stumbling on her little legs and was incontinent. We were informed that she had fallen off of a window sill. Within a few days of her arrival here, her condition deteriorated into a paralysis of her rear legs, and it became evident that she was suffering from a spinal injury common to Dachshunds: a disk herniation. Her living situation prior to relinquishment had not been an ideal one for other reasons, as one of the people she'd been living with was "not good with the dog." She also hadn't been spayed.

At MaxFund, we take our dogs and cats as they are. We provide what they need to survive, thrive, and have a bright future. If they need extensive medical treatment, we find a way to make it happen. That's the commitment we make to our animals. But Daisy Mae's condition is an expensive one to treat. The MRI, the pre-surgery bloodwork, and the surgery itself, will cost around \$7000. Even with a generous discount from Dr. Stephen Lane, the wonderful surgeon at VRCC, we're still going to be taking a big hit on our medical budget, leaving us with scarce resources to face other medical emergencies that may arise before year-end.

Daisy Mae is only 3 years old, and deserves so much more than the unhappy life she's lived so far. With this surgery, she has a wonderful future ahead of her as the best friend to some lucky person or family. The disk repair surgery has a high success rate, and we're confident that she'll regain her mobility and bladder control, and go on to live a great life in her forever home.

So Daisy Mae's holiday wish is to regain her mobility so that she can pitter-patter her way into the heart and home of a great family, using all four of her short little Dachshund legs! She knows, though, that she is not the



only MaxFund animal who may need immediate or urgent medical care. She hopes you can help with the cost of her surgery so that other suffering animals can get the care they need.

MaxFund supporters know that one of our dreams is the establishment of an animal sanctuary, and we hope to make that dream come true one day. Our commitment to the no-kill philosophy means that some of our animals have a long stay at the shelter. While the staff and volunteers do their best to enrich the lives of the animals while they're here, we recognize that some would do better in a sanctuary environment. Some dogs, in particular, find the shelter a stressful place.

Until our dream of a sanctuary is realized, we do seek placements with other no-kill sanctuaries when it is in the animal's best interest. Such was the case with Jake, a mastiff mix who had spent several years at the dog shelter. Such was also the case with Granby and Petchouli, more recent arrivals who were being increasingly stressed by the shelter environment. The sanctuary that kindly took in all three of these great boys is the Majestic Canine Rescue in Yoder, Colorado. Run by Wesley Hogan, Majestic works to socialize and rehabilitate dogs with behavior issues, and seeks great homes for them. They are firmly committed to a no-kill philosophy.



We're happy to report that Jake, Granby, and Petchouli are doing great! MaxFund volunteers visit them from time to time, and report that they are thriving in their new environment. We thank Wesley and Majestic Canine Rescue for giving these good boys a fresh start.

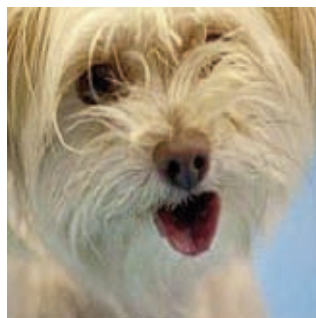

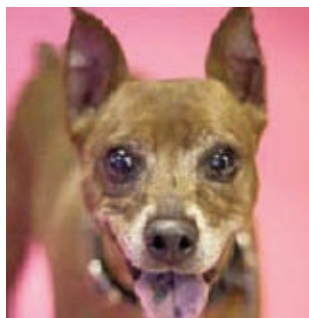

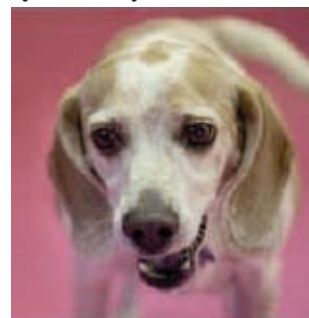
